Abstract can be made more useful for database searches. Some suggestions are: Second sentence is an unnecessary repetition. The sample from Gardes 1-4 can be mentioned to describe Primary school. Use the term research methodology to describe the exploratory research. In the end mention a few main actual findings rather than using vague statements like "some important findings"	
Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?	Yes. The structure of the paper is in fact, very good.	
Please write a few sentences regarding the scientific correctness of this manuscript. Why do you think that this manuscript is scientifically robust and technically sound? A minimum of 3-4 sentences may be required for this part.	The methodology adopted is rigorous and in my view the sampling techniques and sizes are appropriate too. I'm unsure about the validity of some fidings for eg. Religious topics being most popular for Grade 1-4 children! Using Interviews for such a young age subject is an appropriate technique of data gathering but you must mention the bias and validitiy issues resulting from this technique. Clearly, children felt they had to say the right thing rather than the true thing.	
Are the references sufficient and recent? If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form. :	Some of latest researches used as references date back to 2014. This is more than 10 years old data that the paper is based on. More recent papers would be useful as the topic is fast evolving and "New Media" definitions have changed.
