Please provide your comments regarding the appropriateness of different sections of the manuscript.	<p>Introduction - it would be useful to mention the incidence of SLE and PBC, if not mentioned in the earlier chapters.</p> <p>Methods- To include American Rheumatism association criteria (if not mentioned elsewhere)</p> <p>Table 1 – I am unable to see this in manuscript, hence cannot comment.</p> <p>Conclusion mentions – 3 patients were simultaneously diagnosed with SLE and PBC, and 3 patients died. Were these same patients? If so, simultaneous diagnosis has poorer outcome, which needs to be mentioned and elaborated if possible.</p> <p>Although number of patients diagnosed with SLE & PBC combo was small, it would be useful to present any statistical data regarding prognosis or outcomes of such an association.</p> <p>Many autoimmune diseases co-exist. Any Immunological markers or molecular genetics testing data done in these patients and showing commonality in the SLE & PBC combo patients would be an added information to the manuscript.</p>
