Book Chapter (Manuscript) Title: Marine Capture fishing in Pakistan: an industry facing fisherman livelihood implications

This manuscript provides important insights into the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the livelihoods of workers in the fishing industry in Pakistan. The study provides information on the challenges faced by these workers, identifying the most affected groups and the most effective support measures. The sample size was adequate, and the methodology and analysis were appropriate. The findings can guide policymakers in designing assistance for this vulnerable sector.

One of the reviewers was generally positive and recommended minor revisions. However, one of the reviewers gave a very negative assessment. Although the mark given was very low (5.5) the concerns raised did not pertain to fundamental issues in the study and were easily addressed by the authors. I would therefore support publication.
