Although this is a rare complication in individuals with Parkinson disease using low doses of levodopa, its timely identification is of most importance for prognosis. This case is a good example of the problem.

In the case report, it is better to use medication compound instead of the brand; for example, carbidopa/levodopa 25/250 mg instead of Syndopa 250mg. It is not clear to me for how long carbidopa/levodopa 25/250 mg was stopped. Please clarify. It would be good for the reader if the authors could add a table with the proposed criteria for neuroleptic malignant syndrome and another table expanding the differential diagnosis and providing tips for their differentiation (e.g., serotoninergic syndrome, catatonia, etc). There is a typo error with reference number 4 in the second paragraph of the discussion after the phrase "The pathophysiology underlying PHS is generally accepted to be a hypodopaminergic state, and its clinical features can be explained as sequelae of central dopamine depletion."
