

Editor's Comment:

The content of the manuscript is worth publishing, but the language is so poor that practically it is unreadable. I agree, that the construction of sentences may be poor due to the fact that 'English' is not the mother tongue of the authors (it is not mine too) but the sense of singular and plural (which is prevalent starting from the very first sentence of the abstract), comes from the mother tongue itself. The language requires serious editing. I have marked in red, as far as practicable. One sentence in the abstract is a repetition and has been deleted. I don't think that the figure scheme 1 is at all required. Formula should be numbered and must not be repeated. Punctuations are missing at many places, most of which are not marked. Upon thorough revision, the paper may be published.

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
